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Omaui Camp

Just a 30 minute drive from Invercargill, in the coastal Southland community of Omaui, is the Y's Omaui Camp.

Omaui is a unique place; ripe for outdoor adventures whether they be on the beach, in the bush or in the backyard of the camp which has been redeveloped with multiple outdoor adventure activities.

Just two minutes' walk from the beach, and right beside the Omaui Reserve which encompasses 5km of walking tracks - the opportunities for adventure are boundless.

Owned and operated by the Y Southland, Omaui Camp is ideal for school, community, or family groups any time of year.

Accommodation

Omaui Camp can accommodate up to 45 people. There is bunk-style accommodation with 18 beds in each dorm, single rooms off each dorm that can sleep up to four, and two single rooms off the main entrance.

Each dorm has its own heat pump, ensuring a warm stay year-round.

Mattresses are all covered with new, wipeable, hospital-grade covers, but guests are asked to provide their own linen and/or sleeping bags, towels and pillows.





Facilities

All cooking utensils are provided. Facilities for cooking include two gas-top six ring burners with electric ovens. There are two fridges and a freezer.

Mains pressure water and a high-quality filtration system, as well as gas heating ensures there is high quality drinking water and good water pressure for showers.

Outdoor activities

The Y aims to provide a safe, stimulating and caring environment where people of all ages can increase their knowledge, awareness, skills, and self-esteem. There are a wide range of adventure-based activities onsite to support this.

Activity packages are designed so a parent, teacher, or any adult can run the activities safely and effectively. Onsite information packs include full risk and safety management plans.

Onsite activities also include giant Connect Four, cornhole, archery, bush craft, bush cooking on the fire pit, orienteering, a confidence bridge, zip line and a small bouldering wall.

Bring your bike and have a go on the pump track, which includes small jumps, roll overs, a zig zag climb, and board walk ramps. The track is a great way to build skills for mountain biking and is fun for kids and adults!

Exhausted? Take a breath and relax in the evenings and recount the day's activities as you toast marshmallows over the campfire.



Booking information

Hire charges apply to guests who wish to visit for a few hours (day programme), overnight, or over several days/nights. Charges include full and private use of the facility, access to the buildings, accommodation, power, water, and kitchen facilities.
